

# Royal Military Canal

Just to clear up any confusion...

Further to a member's complaint regarding an incident in which they were allegedly bitten by a dog owned by the people living in 'Mill House' (shown below) there appears to be some confusion regarding access & the fishing rights of our section of the Royal Military Canal in that area.



Our first section, Ruckinge Bridge to Mill House

As I read & understand our lease the situation is as follows:

The area & fishing rights we lease are marked in green, this clearly shows & stipulates that it is the "South Bank" only (I also refer to a letter from the EA) **There is NO fishing from the "North Bank"**.

On the lease map there are three points marked (A) Ruckinge Bridge, (B) Mill House & (C) Pump House Bridge.

1. First section: Fishing & access is from Ruckinge Bridge (Point A) **UP TO** the property boundary of Mill House (Point B)
2. Second section: For fishing & access the other side of Mill House (Point B) **ACCESS IS ONLY** gained via "Pump House Bridge" (Point C)

**(i.e. You CAN'T walk through or passed the property of Mill Cottage to gain access to the other side, this can only be done by going (driving) to the next bridge along, "Pump House Bridge" & walking back,)**

I hope this clears up any confusion, LAS will be contacting the owners of Mill House & explain the situation.
