2005 Summer Monday evening comps.

Match No. 2

Date: 4th July 2005.

Venue: River Medway, Watlingbury, Kent

Conditions: Sunny periods, dull most of the time, rain showers, wind – slight to moderate.
It was cold for that time of year. Very little flow at times.

Summary: Venue changed due to weed problems on River Beult at Hawkenbury. Match was a rover so no peg numbers therefore No: 1 was the nearest peg from the Marina end working along the first field. It fished better than the last evening match. Malcolm Paye won again, fishing sweetcorn over hemp on the waggler, catching Bream & Roach. He would have had more but ran out of hemp to loose feed also lost a big Bream which spooked the swim. Fish seem very hungry; you have to feed heavily & frequently, so it takes a lot of bait, especially hemp to keep the fish.
